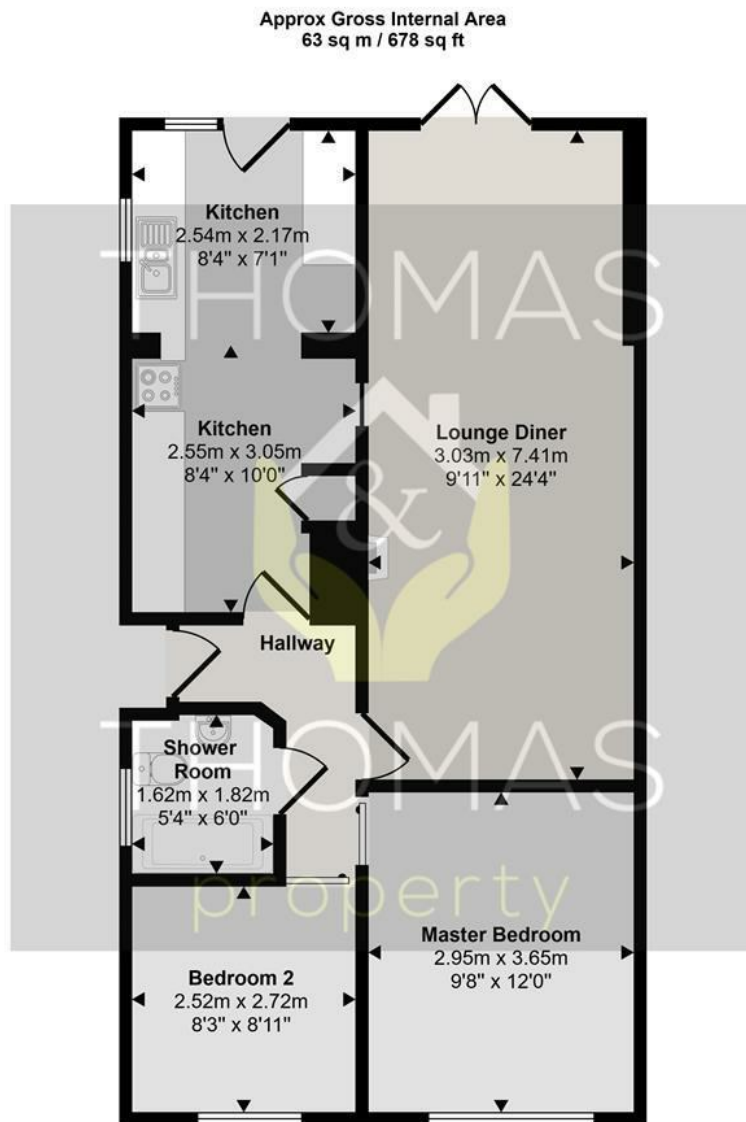

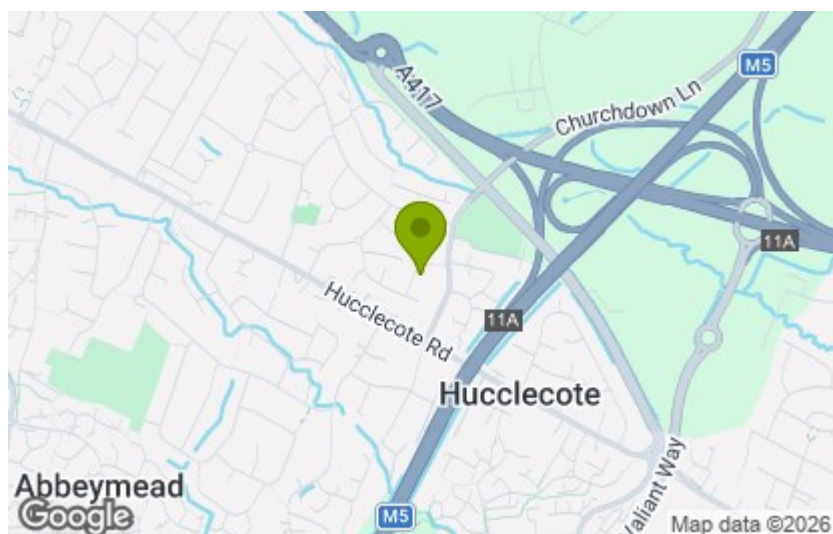


Floorplan
